

CURRICULUM Learning By Doing

ASJV adheres to the curriculum guidelines of CBSE (Central Board Of Secondary Education), the most prestigious national board of India. The curriculum is followed through the integrated use of technology and knowledge from textbooks by NCERT (National Council Of Education Research And Training); Smart class Audio-visual modules; Online smart class, CBIL(concept Based Integrated Learning) which involves TIE (Theatre In Education) as well as AIE (Art In Education). The three language formula, of CBSE is introduced in class V.

PARENT TEACHER INTERACTION

ASJV Organise a Parent-Teacher meeting on a month on month basis and after every Terminal examination or completion of unit test, P.T.M. is organised on every 1st Saturday of the Month for Play Groups and on every 2nd Saturdays for Juniors upto Std 5th.

We at ASJV believe that Parents are the first possible teachers for any child who starts learning from the time of appearing in this world. To tab the student's behaviours after school and to understand what a student do at school we organise this interaction every month. Parents are free to meet the class teachers or subject teachers after school till 15:00 hrs with prior permission.

CONVEYANCE

ASJV has A/C as well as non A/c transport system for it's students for prior programmed routes. Parents can choose these two options according to their convenience. Routs will be determined at the beginning of each academic session. The School deserves the right to make desirable changes in the routes of the cabs any time round the year. Parents shall be informed

about the same time to time.

REGISTRATION FOR ADMISSION :- Timing is Stable to Change

according to the change in season.

- Registration form can be obtained from the school counter on payment of Rs. 250/- only from the last week of December for the coming session.
- The duly filled in form along with required documents must be submitted at the school office during working hours before the admission test is conducted.
- The registered candidates will be called for admission after the admission test/interaction with parents.
- The registration fee is not refundable and registration is not guarantee for admission.









ADMISSION

- Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit.
- There will not be written test for admission to K.G. Children are required to appear for the interview. It is essential for the parents to accompany the child.
- For Classes I to VI tests are conducted in English, Mathematics, Gen. Science & Hindi only.
- The following documents are to be submitted along with the admission form at the time of admission.
 - (a) Date of Birth Certificate (Issued by Municipal Corporation/Municipality or Gram Panchayat)
 - (b) Transfer Certificate from Govt. Registered School (not required for L.K.G., U.K.G. & Std. I)
 - (c) Two Passport Size Photographs.
 - (d) Aadhar Card of the student.
 - (e) Caste Certificate (if belongs to SC/ST/OBC)

FEE RULES

School fee is payable by cash/cheque/draft in month by/ quartely instalments directly at the school office. The fee is payable in the first month of quarter latest by 10th of the month Name, class and admission number should be written on the back of the cheque.

ATTENDANCE

• 75% attendance is essential for promotion to the next class. It is essential as per the CBSE norms.



- No leave is granted except on prior application from parents/guardians for genuine reasons.
- In case of sickness, a medical certificate issued from a registered medical practitioner should be submitted.
- Repeated absence without sanctioned leave or unexplained leave for a week renders students liable to have his name struck off the rolls.
- It is compulsory for a student to attend the school on the first and the last day after Summer Vacation, Puja Vacation, Winter break and all Sundays.

WITHDRAWALS

- Withdrawal from any class must be proceeded by a month's notice in writing or one month's fee in lieu of notice.
- All dues will have to be cleared off before a Transfer Certificate is issued.
- The school authority may ask, without prior notice to the parents, to withdraw the child from the school on any other following grounds :
 - (a) Academic : Constant neglect of studies or failure in the same class for two consecutive sessions.
 - (b) Disciplinary : Those students whose conduct in the opinion of the Principal is harmful in the interest of the school.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- Students must come with their Almanac to School every day.
- Students should be properly dressed in school uniform with decent haircut and polished shoes.
- Student should not wear any ring, ornament, bangle and bracelet in the campus.
- The School shall not be responsible for any article lost in the premises. Student are instructed not to bring costly items like mobile, camera, watch etc. to the school.
- Students are not allowed to leave the school during the school during the school hours unless the authorized guardians come in person to make the request and the order obtained from a competent school authority.
- Students must obey House Captain and Class Monitors on duty.
- Students are recommended to carry water bottles and lunch.
- Students are not allowed to come to school by motorbike.

- The school reserves the right to take severe action and remove the student from the school if
 a student is found guilty or misconduct which includes disfiguring or damaging school
 property, smoking, chewing pan masala, intake of drugs and intoxicants, gambling violence
 with in the school campus, practice of casteism, communalism, unteachability, use of
 crackers, colour etc.
- Students are advised to reach the school premises atleast 15 minutes before the morning assembly. The school gate will be closed 5 minutes before the assembly. Student without a plausible explanation. Disciplinary action will be taken against habitual late comers.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

Parents to kindly note the following :

- 1. The children abide by the School Rules and Regulations
- 2. They check the diary daily for progress and development reports, sign the same and also use the diary for communing with the teachers.
- Children attend the school regularly and are punctual at all times. Persistent late comers will be sent home after a written warning. WALKERS WON'T BE ALLOWED TO ENTER AFTER 10 MINUTES OF THE REPORTING TIME AND THE SCHOOL GATES SHALL BE CLOSED.
- 4. The children come with the required note books and text books daily.
- 5. All homework given to the children is completed in every respect by the specified dates.
- 6. Please check that the child should be in proper school kit everyday.
- 7. The name, class and section of every student should be clearly marked on all his / her belongings.
- 8. The students are not allowed to answer phone calls during school hours or use the school telephone without the permission of the Principal / Incharge.
- 9. The School Management takes all precautions to see that the children are safe so long as they remain in their custody. However, it does not take any responsibility, whatsoever, for any damage or injury which may be sustained by the student as a result of any accident in the school or in the school or in use conveyance provided by the school or in any other manner.
